

From the President...



From the Online Sales Director...

2021 has certainly been a challenging year for FOL Online. Even with COVID-19, much activity has been happening on a daily basis with listing, maintaining databases, managing inventory, processing sales, and shipping items to our customers.

As of July 31, the inventory count for our AbeBooks and eBay online stores was 11,090. For the year, 1,524 items have been shipped to our customers. Shipments have been sent to 43 states, in addition to 25 foreign countries, all while maintaining a positive customer satisfaction rate of over 99%.

The highest price for an individual item sold in July was \$278, but for 2021, the year-to-date highest individual sale was \$764. Of our total items sold in 2021, 22 were purchased for \$200 or greater.

People are tired of my saying “the customers cannot buy what we do not have listed.” That being said, we are in need of additional persons to help us identify, research, list, and sell items for our FOL Online stores. If you are interested in learning more about Online Sales, contact Dianne or myself and we will be happy to show you around and teach you what we do.

Friday, Members Only: 9:00 am til 3:00 pm


Saturday, Open to Public: 9:00 am til 3:00 pm
