




What a wonderful end to 2017, and now we are on to 2018.


I wish to express the gratitude I have for all the individuals, members, volunteers, and Online personnel who have helped make our Online program such a growing success!

In 2018, through February month end, we have contributed \$17,325 to FOL, which is \$5,402 over the same period 2017. This is an increase of 45.3% YTY growth. If you would like to help us out, we can always use some extra volunteers in Online—lots to do, never a lack of opportunity!



There will be new programs for library online customers, digital signage to keep you informed of all library activities, replacement of the old donation shed at Groves branch, some new equipment for the Mahon children's Storytime Room, and other shelving for two of the branches. 
- <u>Spring Sale: May 4 and 5</u>, 9:00am to 5:00pm, open to the public.


