


All of our wonderful patrons who donate items for us to sell. Without you we wouldn't exist!


## From the Treasurer...



# From the Library Director...

#### Hello, Friends!

What an absolutely wild ride our libraries have been on! Each time I sit down to write an update for our libraries, something changes that makes all of the previous updates into "old news"! By the time you read this, there may be more updates that are not included here, so please know that you can always email or call me with updates, but I will do my best with some high points of library updates.

Groves, Godeke, and Mahon libraries are open and operating at our normal hours. Patterson is closed to provide drive-through testing to the community. We do not have an ETA for Patterson to open, but we are proud to be helping our community with the testing services. Even though we do have three libraries open, the computer labs are not yet open and we are awaiting more direction and help to get those open in a safe and secure manner. We hope that our computer labs will be open in mid-July!

As of Monday, June 29th, all patrons, staff, visitors, volunteers, and contractors must wear a mask at all times while in the library. We do anticipate this to be a temporary measure and when the city-wide new cases decrease, I believe the mandatory mask order will be lifted. But in the meantime, staff is making sure that visitors are in compliance with the declaration, and we are doing all we can to ensure that the library is not an exposure site. We are cleaning each book that comes into the library, quarantining it for 72 hours, and we have all staff sanitizing the library by zones on a daily basis. We are in full compliance with Lubbock Safe! guidelines and we appreciate all you have done to be sure that we can meet that goal.

One major change that we have had to make due to the COVID-19 pandemic involved the overhaul of our Summer Reading Program. Our 2020 summer reading program "Imagine Your Story" is in full swing, and even though we have had to adjust to an all virtual and online format, our librarians have all pitched in to create an engaging and innovative program with crafts and live storytimes and program presenters! We have all the appealing components that we have always had in our Summer Reading Programs, but this year it is all online. In upcoming years we will continue our virtual element to all of our programs and summer reading, and as great as this has all turned out, we do look forward to time when we can host in-person programs in the library. We are expecting this to be as soon as August. So stay tuned as we work toward achieving the "new normal," whatever that may bring to libraries!

Thanks to all of the FOL volunteers for supporting our programs on social media, for signing up for our Adult (and all ages) summer reading programs online (see details on the **City of Lubbock Library** website, ci.lubbock.tx.us/ departments/library) and for all you do for our libraries. We are so lucky to have you working alongside us during these challenging times. We will come out on the other side together!
